



SAFE

If your dog chews or eats any of these, it's advisable to seek veterinary help immediately.



PANSIES

These are considered safe for domestic animals. But ingestion may cause an upset stomach so be careful if using in hanging baskets.



ROSES

This plant is considered non-toxic to pets (make sure they are actually a part of the rose family and don't just have the word rose in the name)



ROSEMARY

This plant is great for creating a sensory garden for your dog. Rosemary helps energise



SNAP DRAGON

Colourful snapdragons are non-toxic to dogs, cats and horses



MINT

Refreshing for your dog to sniff. It can help bad breath too



BARLEY GRASS

This plant can help dogs if they have an upset stomach



LAVENDER

This plant has calming and soothing effect for dogs



CHAMOMILE

This plant has a calming effect for dogs



CAMELLIAS

Non-toxic if touched or ingested



ECHINACEA

(purple coneflower)
These are know to be safe for dogs



AFRICAN VIOLETS

These are know to be safe for dogs and cats (indoor plant)



MICHAELMAS DAISIES



HONEYSUCKLE



NOT SAFE

If your dog chews or eats any of these, it's advisable to seek veterinary help immediately.



ENGLISH IVY

Especially the leaves can cause serious gastrointestinal distress



LILY

All parts of this plant are toxic; flower, pollen and stamen



SNOWDROPS

Bulbs are highly toxic if ingested and can cause gastrointestinal upset or affect the nervous system



MARIGOLDS

Mildly toxic to dogs when ingested and can cause irritation when touched



IRIS

Bulb, leaves and roots are toxic



POPPY

Ingestion of any part of the plant is toxic and can cause sedation, depression coma or even death



PEONY

Severe gastrointestinal upset if ingested



ALOE VERA

Toxic if leaves are eaten



FERNS

These are toxic to dogs including the berries



HOLLY

Toxic to humans and pets when ingested



HYACINTH

Flowers are toxic if eaten.



TULIPS

Ingestion can lead to intense vomiting, depression, hyper-salivation and loss of appetite



SWEET PEA

Contains a toxic chemical that can cause death if ingested



FOXGLOVES

Extremely poisonous to dogs, cats and humans. Can cause cardiac failure.



DAFFODILS

These beautiful spring flowers are extremely toxic to pets, especially the bulbs
